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Abstract:

But all this happens only in urban area of the country; still today in rural area academic libraries are functioning traditionally.

INTRODUCTION

There are very few libraries in rural area which are automated and provide services through newer technologies. Academic libraries support teaching, learning, research and other academic programmes and for that libraries must provide maximum information with the help of internet based services and electronic collection of reading materials. For satisfying the needs of students, all these academic libraries of rural area have to be changed and must adopt computer and other ICT tools to provide internet based service.

PRESENT SITUATION IN RURALAREA:

In India many college libraries of rural area don't have appropriate facilities to fit the needs of their students. College library can be a tool in student's development because libraries promote information literacy and also provide several resources and services. So it's a responsibility of librarian and library staff that every student who comes to the library gets the satisfactory service.

BARRIERS IN OPTIMUM USE OF LIBRARY:

Limited or poor services of the library. Outdated collection. Close access to collection. Rude or unprofessional behavior of library staff. Biased response to student's request. Lack of knowledge about the new technologies. Failed to do optimum use of Internet.

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INCREASING LIBRARY USE:

Information Literacy:

Students must know how to handle dictionaries, encyclopedias and other information sources to find specific information regarding the query. Electronic Resources:

To attract the students, librarian must develop the collection of electronic reading materials. There should be separate section in the library for electronic resources, so students can use it to learn more about interested topics related to curriculum.

Improve Library Atmosphere:

The unstructured and non-decorated library failed to attract students. For making a library more comfortable and attractive place to visit, it's very important to keep the library clean. For the brightness and ventilation do the systematic arrangement of shelves.

Healthy Communication:

For enhancing the use of library it's essential to increase healthy communication between library staff and students, and its responsibility of librarian. Rude and unprofessional behavior, biased responses really affects the library use. So to avoid this librarian must implement some programmes to increase communication between the library staff and students.

Motivation:

Motivation is the important factor to increasing reading habit and enhancing library use. Best practices like a Reading Competition. Best Reader Award helps to motivate students to read.

Interpretation of Library Services:

Students must know about the services available in the library, for that interpretation of the library services is important. Librarian should work out the interpretation of library services plan using talented student's help to arrange exhibition, to do art and sign work, and to keep library attractive. Students must know what is Book Bank Service, Inter-Library Loan Service, Current Awareness Service and other services available in the library.

LIBRARY INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMME:


